When a study revealed that 90% of start-up ecovillages fail in the short-term, the Global Ecovillage Network appointed a committee to study the long-term successful sustainable communities. This was a ten-year study for the purpose of finding the "glue" that holds a community together for the long run. Their findings became the curriculum for the month-long Ecovillage Development Education course that is hosted by The Findhorn Foundation in Scotland. Carol attended this course and became very inspired by the first-hand practical experience of sustainable living among fellow earth-loving kindred spirits. She has distilled the essence of that community living into her weekend workshops so attendees will not only come away with valuable information, they will also get a good taste of sustainable community living.



SCHEDULE: Friday evening September 10, 2010 7-9pm: Carol will share the 7 essential ingredients that the Global Ecovillage Network study found to be the glue that holds successful communities together, including their finding that if it's not fun it's not sustainable.

Saturday September 11, 2010 10am-5pm: This day will be a mix of talking about aspects of sustainable living at the Findhorn Foundation as well as experiential exercises that are designed to bond community members. A large salad will be co-created for lunch.

Sunday September 12, 2010 11am-5pm: Fun! Fun! Fun! Starts with a potluck brunch followed by storytelling, music, dancing, sharing and merrymaking. Closes with a compassionate listening circle.
